### **Top 10 Host Family Guidelines**

- Remember, these young teenagers are our guests and responsibility. They should be treated as you would treat any other member of your family.
- Please provide breakfast, lunch and dinner each day unless other plans have been arranged. When traveling around, please ensure your guests have bottled water or something else to drink.
- You will be required to take your guests to their scheduled activities. Please make sure they arrive early.
- Hosts should recognize that members of the soccer team are young teens and full of energy. When activities are not scheduled they would love to do some site seeing of our fine city. Our idea of fun and a teenager may be different. On free days, the hosts may want to ask the guests what they would like to do, or give them choices of activities.
- The team members will need rest to prepare them for their soccer tournament. Please avoid the temptation to schedule too many activities.
- Remember, these are teenagers. They may need extra enticing to get them to go to bed or getting them up in the morning.
- Hosts should try to operate their homes in as normal a manner as possible. Our young guests want to learn about our usual family life.
- Hosts should take full advantage of this opportunity to learn about the kids and their country. Have fun with this once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to share in the wonderful world of youth and international fellowship!
