Mark Hall-Patton is the Museums Administrator for the Clark County museum system, where he oversees the Clark County Museum, the Howard W. Cannon Aviation Museum, and the Searchlight History Museum. He has been with Clark County for twenty-three years, and was previously the Director of the San Luis Obispo County Historical Museum in California. He has worked for both public and private non-profit museums, and has consulted with

numerous start-up and established museums and museum boards.

He is a MAP surveyor for the American Alliance of Museums, and the author of two books, over 400 published articles, and has written and produced 48 local history videos. In 2009, he hosted a live interview program on C4 television in the Vegas valley, and is regularly seen on the History Channel's Pawn Stars as a visiting expert. He has also appeared on American Restoration, United Stuff of America, America Facts and Fallacies,10 Things You Don't Know About American History, TMZ Sports, CSPAN 3, Mysteries at the Museum, Hoarders, PBS, and the BBC Radio World Service.

In addition to 14 years as a Board member of the Nevada Museums Association, where he served as President from 2000-2002 and 2008-2010, he has served on the California Association of Museums and Western Museums Association boards. He is a member of the board of the Nevada Test Site Historical Foundation, and the Nevada Aerospace Hall of Fame. He has been in the museum field for over 38 years, having also worked with museums in California and South Dakota. He holds a BA in History from the University of California at Irvine, and did graduate work in Museum Studies at the University of Delaware.

He is married to Dr. Colleen Hall-Patton, professor of Sociology and Women's Studies at UNLV, and they are the parents of Joseph and Ellen Hall-Patton.





George Crockett



George Crockett died Sunday morning of a heart attack. He was a 50year resident of Las Vegas.

Ğeorge was inducted into the Rotary Club of Las Vegas in October, 1959 and maintained continuous membership. On many occasions he of-

fered his airplane for Rotary's charitable activities and to attend meetings in California. Since 1965, the annual demotion parties for club presidents have been held on the grounds of his home.

George was the founder and builder of the Alamo Airways Airport, located where McCarran International Airport is today. In the late 1940s, following a complicated series of transactions, the Alamo Airways Airport changed hands from George to Clark County.

In the final transaction, he was paid \$45,000 and given a lease for 40 acres of ground on which he operated Alamo, a company that serviced non-airline airplanes. Following the 1967 sale of Alamo to Summa Corp., George retired.

He was born on March 31, 1912, in Unionville, Mo. He attended aviation school in Missouri before he arrived in Las Vegas.

He is survived by his wife Margaret of Las Vegas; daughters, Catherine of Las Vegas and Darla Jean of San Mateo, Calif.; sons Chris of Reno and George of San Mateo; seven grandchildren; and one great-grandchild.

George is a great-great-great grandson of the legendary Davy Crockett of Tennessee.

Memorial services will be private. Instead of flowers, the family has asked that donations be sent to the Boy Scouts of America, Boulder Dam Area Council in George's name.
