In 2001, he joined Las Vegas Events as its President. During his tenure, LVE has averaged 45 events per year, up from 21 the year before he arrived. Las Vegas Events produces or sponsors the National Finals Rodeo, Life is Beautiful, USA Sevens, three Conference Basketball Tournaments, USABasketball, NBA Summer League, Rock 'N' Roll Las Vegas Marathon and America's Party (New Year's Eve reworks).

In 2017, Christenson released a book, Rock Vegas. It is about the evolution of live music in Las Vegas.

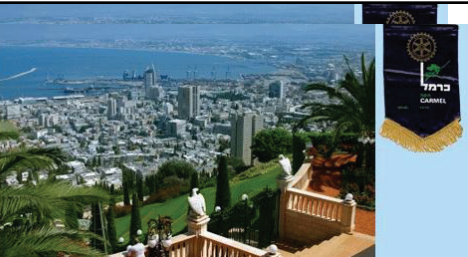

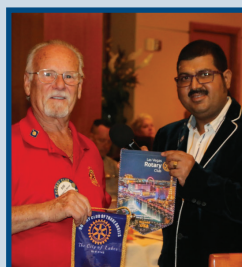

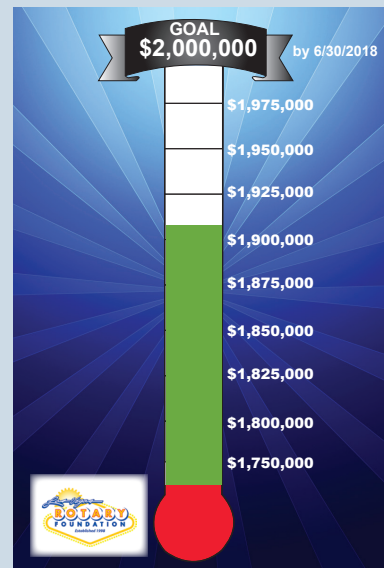
