Dear Rotarians

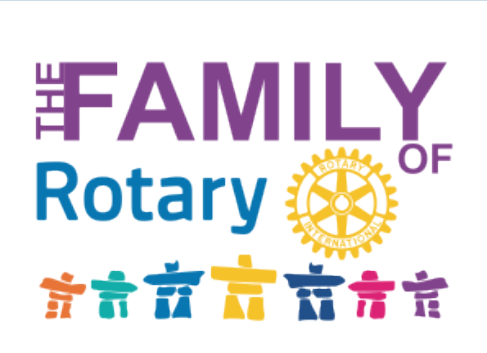

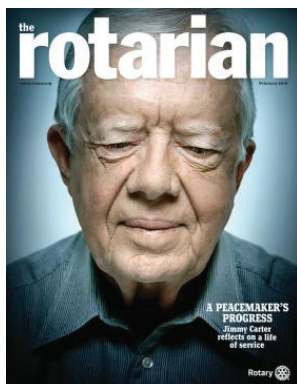
