# John J. Entsminger

## Las Vegas Water Department



John J. Entsminger oversees the operations of the Southern Nevada Water Authority, which is responsible for acquiring, treating and delivering water to local agencies that collectively serve 2 million residents and more than 40 million annual visitors, and the Las Vegas Valley Water District, which serves more than 375,000 customer accounts. He was appointed general manager by both agencies' Boards of Directors in early 2014, having previously served as director of environmental and water resource law and senior deputy general manager. Entsminger joined the organization in 1999 as an attorney.

Entsminger has spent his career addressing the unique water challenges facing Southern Nevada. He has been instrumental in developing inter basin and international agreements protecting Lake Mead water elevations, including the 2007 Colorado River Interim Guidelines and Minutes 319 and 323 to the 1944 U.S. - Mexico Water Treaty. In April 2014, he was appointed by Governor Sandoval to serve as Nevada's lead negotiator on Colorado River matters.

On the national front, Entsminger serves on the Boards of Directors of the Association of Metropolitan Water Agencies and the Water Research Foundation, and the Desert Research Institute Foundation Board of Trustees. Committed to public involvement, Entsminger works closely with a committee of community stakeholders tasked with making recommendations on issues related to funding, planning and facilities construction and maintenance. Entsminger is a graduate of the University of Northern Colorado and of the University of Colorado School of Law. He and his family have been in Las Vegas for nearly 20 years.

## MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

Each month of the year has a Rotary theme. March's theme is providing clean water, sanitation, and hygiene. This is also one of Rotary's six areas of focus because, "[c]lean water, sanitation, and hygiene education are basic necessities for a healthy environment and a productive life." Access to clean water and sanitation results in better health. The benefits of clean water include: that when healthy, children are able to attend more school days, increasing their level of education; women who are typically tasked with gathering water, are freed to support their families in other ways; and men and women who are not sick are able to work more, improving their standard of living. Clean water and sanitation projects provide meaningful improvement to the quality of life for third world inhabitants.

Water projects come in many forms. In Lebanon, all 24 of its Rotary clubs set aside their religious, cultural and political differences and formed a partnerships that included the government, World Vision, UNICEF, and the Red Cross to develop a program that delivers clean water to every public school in the country. In the Philippines, Rotary partnered with other groups to build 222 toilets, six rainwater collectors, seven communal handwashing stations, and 20 biosand filters for rural communities that lacked basic sanitation. The joint project provided more than 1,000 people with access to proper toilet facilities and almost 600 people with a regular supply of clean water. In India, Rotary clubs partnered with local organizations to install a rainwater harvesting and distribution center for 4,000 people. They also delivered training programs for women in the community and students in 35 schools.

Rotary only supports sustainable local solutions for clean water, sanitation, and hygiene. When we commit to a project, we work with local community leaders to make sure they understand the project and the community is able to maintain it for years to come. Due to their benefits across society, Rotary has and will continue to support and work on sustainable projects that provide clean water and sanitation to those who do not have them. Just as a rising tide lifts all boats, clean water improves all lives.

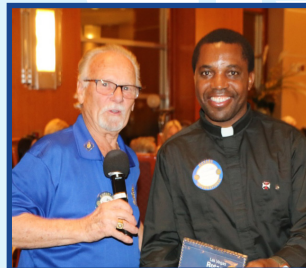
**Tina Bishop** led us in song with "God Bless America".
