



Coach T.J. Otzelberger

UNLV Basketball Runnin' Rebels



T.J. Otzelberger became the 14th full-time head coach in UNLV men's basketball history on March 27, 2019.

Otzelberger came to UNLV after serving as head coach at South Dakota State University for three seasons (2016-19), leading the Jackrabbits to two NCAA Tournaments and one NIT appearance.

Otzelberger ("OTTs-ell-BURGER") lifted the program at South Dakota State to new heights, where he compiled an overall record of 70-33, led the Jackrabbits to

three straight postseason appearances, clinched the outright regular-season Summit League title the past two seasons, and earned the conference's Coach of the Year honors.

Under Otzelberger, the Jackrabbits were one of the top offensive teams in the nation, ranking in the top 10 among all NCAA teams in scoring during the last two seasons: 2017-18 (7th), 2018-19 (5th).

A native of Milwaukee, Wisconsin, Otzelberger, 41, earned a degree from the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater where he played collegiately and was a two-year team captain. His coaching career started at Burlington Catholic Central High School in Wisconsin before spending one season at Chipola JC in Florida.

Otzelberger is married to Alison Lacey, a former Iowa State standout who also played for the WNBA's Seattle Storm. The couple has three children, Jayce, Olivia and Stella.

As many of you know, I grew up in Philadelphia, PA. When I was in high school I became very interested in sports and began to follow the local professional teams. I was also exposed to collegiate men's basketball which is extremely popular in Philadelphia due to the annual big five tournament among the division 1 colleges located in the metropolitan area. Like many sporting fans I fell in love with March Madness, the NCAA men's basketball championship.

Coach Otzelberger was formerly of the South Dakota State Jackrabbits and was the 2018 Summit League coach of the year. 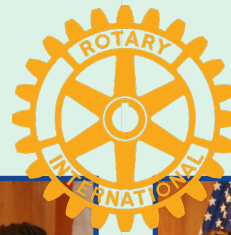

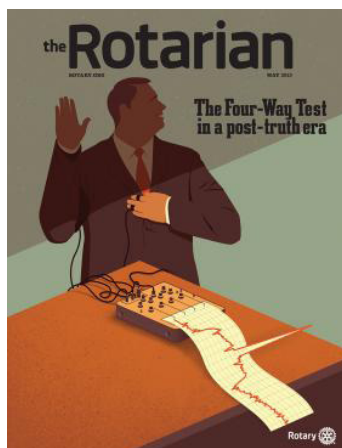
