Memorial Day is an American holiday, observed annually on the last Monday of May, honoring the men and women who died while serving in the U.S. military. Originally known as Decoration Day, it originated in the years following the Civil War and became an official federal holiday in 1971. Many Americans observe Memorial Day by visiting cemeteries or memorials, holding family gatherings and participating in parades. The Civil War, which ended in the spring of 1865, claimed more lives than any conflict in U.S. history and required the establishment of the country's first national cemeteries. By the late 1860s, Americans in various towns and cities had begun holding springtime tributes to these countless fallen soldiers, decorating their graves with flowers and reciting prayers. It is unclear where exactly this tradition originated; numerous different communities may have independently initiated the memorial gatherings. Nevertheless, in 1966 the federal government declared Waterloo, New York, the official birthplace of Memorial Day. Waterloo—which first celebrated the day on May 5, 1866—was chosen because it hosted an annual, community-wide event, during which businesses closed and residents decorated the graves of soldiers with flowers and flags. Memorial Day, as Decoration Day gradually came to be known, originally honored only those lost while fighting in the Civil War. But during World War I the United States found itself embroiled in another major conflict, and the holiday evolved to commemorate American military personnel who died in all wars.

MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

Today our program remembers and honors those who gave their lives in service of our country. While we have all seen movies where a mother answers the door to learn that her son was killed in action, that scene does not tell the whole story.

This weekend I attended the funeral of Garrett Meriwether. Garrett was a friend of the family and the son of our friends Steve and Debbie. He was just 18 years old when he was killed by a driver who is charged with driving while intoxicated. Garrett's wake, funeral service and gravesite burial were the saddest and most heart-wrenching events that I have ever attended. I don't know how Garrett's parents made it through these first few days; nor do I know how they will grapple with this new reality in the weeks, months and years to come. I literally cried for three days. And, it wasn't just me. The entire village that helped raised Garrett - and all of our kids - cried over the premature loss of the Meriwether's son; this included the priests performing the Christian Rite of Burial.

While attending Garrett's ceremonies, I got to thinking about how the village that raised Garrett all mourned his loss and how the villages of soldiers who were killed in action experienced the same pain. While the image of the mother crumpling to her knees in tears when she receives the news that her son has been killed in combat is accurate, it omits the impact that such a devastating loss has upon immediate family, extended family, close family friends, and other people from the soldier's village that also feel the sharp pain for the loss of one of their own. According to PBS more than 1.1 million American soldiers have been killed in combat since the birth of our nation. 1.1 million villages stood together at funerals, gravesites and other memorials and cried for the loss of their child. When we remember our fallen soldiers each year we pray for their souls. We should also pray that their family, friends and fellow villagers are able to find peace and comfort in not only that hour of need, but in the days, weeks, months and years moving forward - so they know their loved one's sacrifice had meaning and that their sacrifice is recognized and appreciated by all in order to make this world in which we live a better place.

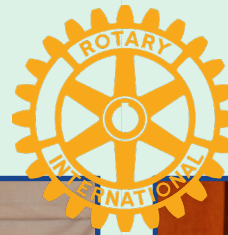

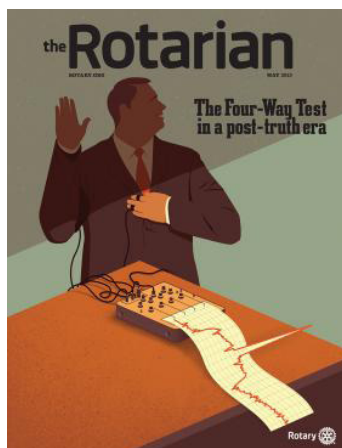
