Given Rob's desire to make a greater difference in the community, Rob chose the opportunity to run for the office of the Public Administrator when the incumbent elected official chose to retire. Rob's experience at Accolade Law gave Rob the qualifications that allowed him to hit the ground running when he entered into his office as the Clark County Public Administrator.

Rob has increased the efficiency of the office through new policies and procedures. Rob has furthered the mission of the office by speeding up the locating of family and the administration of estates. While the Public Administrator's Office has been reduced to a minimum staff during the coronavirus pandemic response, the Public Administrator's office has been able to continue safeguarding property for families.




