


Martin Stroanac NDOT Projects in the Las Vegas Valley







- Polio Plus (Kim Nyoni) fundraising was on our pledge forms for members to contribute Polio Plus. Kim outlined that work performed by Rotary and the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, including dozens of other partners to eradicate polio in all but two countries, Pakistan and Afghanistan. In addition to these efforts, Vegas PBS will be airing the Polio Crusade on Tuesday, June 15 at 9 PM. Nikki Bates provided the background that an individual, Basil O'Connor, crusaded to all people to contribute to the eradication of Polio. Envelopes of change flooded the Whitehouse and out of this response the March of Dimes was born. Nikki announced another programing featured by Vegas PBS through Channel 10. STEAM camp (Science Technology Education and Math) just won an Emmy award this past Friday night. The new season which MGM Grand has sponsored, will begin Friday, June 19 at 9 AM and 2 PM. If you have children and grandchildren, this is the program for them. Vegas PBS video highlights kids doing experiments at home. Tune in next Friday, as the Thunderbirds video recorded for STEAM camp, explains how the Thunderbirds fly so fast. Kim mentioned Page 7 of this week's wheel, highlights the lifecycle of Polio. He hopes members will keep Polio Plus contributions in mind as they contribute to Rotary programs.

- Introducing the Speaking Program by Toni Kern, Spread The Word Nevada (Lisa Habighorst & Pam Lang)has celebrated its 20th anniversary. Since 2001 it has distributed \$6 mil free books to children in low income communities throughout Nevada. The Las Vegas Rotary Club has supported this organization through donations as early as 2007. Lesley and Tom Thomas contributed 12,500, again today with a donation from the Las Vegas Rotary Foundation of \$12,500 for Beckley Elementary school. The school has already been adopted for Kids 2 Kids and Breakfast With Books (family reading program). Another project is the mentor program, Books With Buddies which has the highest attendance. A big thank you Marie Walsh for her part with this program, a 1:1 program including Beckley and other schools. The programs are being managed by Lisa and Pam at Spread the Word. The bios of both women are on the front page of the wheel with photos. This summer is BOB Books On Break produced to diminish a slide in reading for children in need. When COVID closed schools they formed Direct Care for Kids. They were able to serve 25,000 kids in 10 weeks through collaborative efforts with the CCSD and business partners delivering supplies and books to children. Improvement of virtual learning has been the catalyst to help them achieve a goal to reach children in rural areas.


