

MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

Have you heard of the Rabbit Effect? In the 1970s, researchers in New Zealand set up an experiment to determine the effects of diet on heart health. For several months, they fed a control group of genetically identical rabbits a high-fat diet and monitored their blood pressure, heart rate, and cholesterol.

As expected, all of the rabbits showed a buildup of fatty deposits on the inside of their arteries. They were surprised by one thing though, one group surprisingly had as much as 60 percent less than the others. To scientists, results like this can negate the findings of the research. If the rabbits each received equal amounts of the same food, how could one group be so different?

The scientists sought to figure it out. One day, they noticed something different in this peculiar group. The researcher in charge of that group was showing 'her' rabbits more attention than the other caretakers. She would pick the rabbits up, talk to, pet and cuddle them.

Although the experiment was trying to solve the riddle of heart health, it stumbled upon a big piece of the wellness puzzle—kindness matters. Compassion and kindness extend and improve our lives.

Other scientists continued research into non-medical indications of longevity. In 2019, Columbia University doctor Kelli Harding published a book, The Rabbit Effect, where she writes about the latest groundbreaking discoveries in the science of compassion, kindness, and human connection. Her insights are thought provoking and beneficial.

As I read more on the research, I often thought about how Rotary provides us an opportunity to have deep human connections and show kindness and compassion on a regular basis. As Rotarians let's not pass any opportunities to be kind and compassionate. It will improve and extend our lives and the lives of those around us.


