MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

During the Great Depression in 1932, Herbert Taylor, a member of the Rotary Club of Chicago, was asked to take over a near-bankrupt aluminum company. Taylor's first order of business was to draft a code of conduct to guide its people in their decisions.

The company used four questions to guide its business decisions. Taylor called these questions the Four-Way Test and declined business that failed to meet the test. The company thrived as a result. Taylor shared the Four-Way Test as he progressed through Rotary leadership.

Rotary International officially adopted the Four-Way Test in 1943. When Herbert Taylor became RI president in 1954, he donated the copyright of the Four-Way Test to the organization.

The purpose of The Four-Way Test is to remind us in "all we think, say, and do..." to be ethical and moral. Being truthful and honest is so important it is the first question in The Four-Way Test: "Is it the TRUTH?"

Renowned author on leadership and ethics, John Maxwell, gives two reasons why people make dishonest or inappropriate choices. First, people tend to do what's most convenient. They fall into the trap of doing what's easy, but not necessarily what's right. Second, people do whatever it takes to win; what they call "win at any cost." If it's a choice between winning by being unethical, or being ethical and perhaps losing — then ethics loses.

In the short term, being honest is sometimes harder, puts us at risk of losing opportunities and can be hurtful to others.

Being honest requires humility and strength. It builds trust with family members, friends, customers and others. Having integrity and building trust are prerequisites to having true joy—knowing you've accomplished things the right way.




