BULLET TRAIN TO LA

Last week's guest speaker, Greta Seidman, who directs public affairs activities for Brightline West, gave us a very informative update of the future of the Bullet Train to LA. She talked about the success of the project in Florida and what to expect here in Las Vegas within the next seven years.

Brightline West is a shovel ready high-speed rail project and is poised to bring economic and environmental benefits to the Southern Nevada. It will utilize fully electric, zero emission trains to connect Las Vegas and Los Angeles through multiple intercity projects. It is expected to carry more than 11 million passengers annually.

Guests departing Las Vegas will have fast and convenient access to all of the Greater Los Angeles area from station points in the Victor Valley, Rancho Cucamonga and Palmdale with direct access via California Metrolink to key points in Los Angeles, such as Union Station.

Brightline Holdings has achieved a significant milestone with the successful acquisition of a 110-acre parcel on Las Vegas Blvd. that will serve as the future Las Vegas home for Brightline West. Plans are currently being developed for the terminal station, which will encompass 65,000 square feet of building area and include many innovative amenities for travelers, including ample parking and connections to various ground transportation systems – both existing and planned.




