

# Brig. Gen. Evan Pettus Vice Commander, U.S. Air Force Warfare Center



Brig. Gen. Pettus is the Vice Commander, U.S. Air Force Warfare Center, Nellis Air Force Base, Nevada. The USAFWC is organized under Air Combat Command into five wings and two named units with more than 13,000 military and civilian personnel serving in the 57th Wing, 53rd Wing, 99th Air Base Wing, 505th Command and Control Wing, 350th Spectrum Warfare Wing, the Nevada Test and Training Range, and the Air Force Joint Test Program Office. The USAFWC conducts operational testing and tactics development programs as well as advanced training schools, exercises and venues. The center develops innovative leaders and provides Airman with proven

and tested technology, the most current tactics, academic training, and opportunities to practice integrated force employment.

Prior to assuming this assignment, Brig. Gen. Pettus was the Commander, 378th Air Expeditionary Wing, Prince Sultan Air Base, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, where he was responsible for the plans, support, and execution of military operations in support of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, and for providing counter-air, aerial interdiction, and close-air support capabilities to U.S. Central Command. His staff experiences include serving as the Commandant at the Air Command and Staff College, as the Chief of the Commander's Action Group for U.S. Air Forces in Europe, and as the Deputy Assistant Chief of Staff for Operations for U.S. Forces Korea.

Brig. Gen. Pettus earned his commission from the U.S. Air Force Academy in 1994. He graduated from Euro-NATO Joint Jet Pilot Training at Sheppard AFB, Texas, and was first stationed at Royal Air Force Lakenheath, United Kingdom, as an F-15E pilot. He is a graduate of the U.S. Air Force Weapons School and is a command pilot with more than 2,600 hours in the T-37 Tweet, T-38 Talon, AT-38 Talon, and F-15E Strike Eagle. He has flown combat missions in operations Northern Watch, Southern Watch, Allied Force, Enduring Freedom, and Iraqi Freedom.



# MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

At dawn on the morning of November 11, 1918, two railroad cars arrived in remote France. One carried German military officers; the other, Allied commanders. They were gathering for a meeting that would make history. It was there that leaders of these two military forces signed an armistice—an agreement to end years of deadly conflict. At the 11th hour on the 11th day of the 11th month, World War I was over.

In recognition of this day of peace and hope, United States President Woodrow Wilson designated November 11 as Armistice Day, which would later be renamed Veterans Day. "To us in America," he declared, "the reflections of Armistice Day will be filled with solemn pride in the heroism of those who died in their country's service and with gratitude for the victory."

Shortly after peace was declared, an American soldier, Ira Schubert, wrote to his girlfriend back home: "No doubt the people in the States went wild over the signing of the armistice. But you can't imagine the feelings of the boys who went through the hardships one encounters in a war-swept country. The only way they could celebrate the victory was to pat each other on the back and thank Almighty God that they survived the experience."

Today marks the 103rd anniversary of the armistice. We must remember and appreciate not just those who fought but what they fought for. For generations, millions of Americans have answered the call to serve taking the sacred oath to defend and preserve our Nation's ideals of liberty and democracy. In doing so, so many veterans have sacrificed their lives or their wellbeing to fulfill that oath.

The veterans of World War I are all gone now, and Ira Schubert was right—we may never really know what they went through. However, we can and should thank Almighty God that they were willing to go through it.

As Rotarians today, we pay tribute to their courage and we should ensure that their service and sacrifice set a standard that is forever remembered and revered. It was truly service above self.


